

Job Fair begins in city today

Job fair-2005 begins today (Sunday) at Osmani Memorial Hall with leading 20 companies with the intention of providing job against three hundred posts.

Minister for Education Dr. M. Osman Farruk will inaugurate the two-day fair at 10:30 am today (Sunday) while the State Minister for Finance and Planning Shah Mohammed Abul Hossain will attend as chief guest at the concluding session to be held at 6 pm on tomorrow (Monday).

"An unbridled rise in unemployments is creating frustration among the youths. We want to create a base for the national initiative of providing the unemployed educated youths of the country," said Hossain-al-Masum, Executive Director of Youth Employment Society and Chairman of Job Fair Committee at a Press conference held at the National Press Club on Saturday.

He said Youth Employment Society have decided to make a bridge between the employers and the intended jobseekers as the unemployment was one of the big problems in the country.

Hossain Al Masum said 3500 candidates have applied against

the vacant posts in the website. Those who are interested to submit their applications directly at the fair have been requested to place it with the CVs and two copies of photographs. The scrutiny of applications, counsel session and interviews will be taken at the spot on the first day of the fair.

On the second day a seminar on 'everyones employment planning is needed for the sake of development' will be held at 10 am at the Osmani Memorial Hall. Eminent economist Professor Mozaffar Ahmad will preside over the seminar.

He hoped that the representatives from the employment companies will attend the fair and the appointment letters will be issued instantly on August 8.

The Press conference was attended among others, by Editor of the Desh Bangla Ferdous Ahmed Kureshi, Syed Rashidul Huda Chowdhury and Lokman Hossain.
